# LEMON LAW QUALIFICATIONS

## COVERED VEHICLES

Purchased or leased a defective vehicle in California having a substantial defect covered under warranty



## WHEN DOES A VEHICLE QUALIFY?

If the manufacturer or dealer fails to fix a warranty defect impacting the vehicles use, safety, or value, after a reasonable number of attempts (usually 2 or more)

## WHAT IS CONSIDERED "REASONABLE"?

- Multiple Failed Repairs – Repeated unsuccessful attempts to fix the defect
- Safety Concerns – The defect poses a serious risk
- Excessive Downtime – Vehicle is in the shop 30+ days for warranty repairs



## YOUR RIGHTS

If your vehicle qualifies, the manufacturer must:

- Repurchase the Vehicle
- Provide a Cash Settlement
- Continued Ownership with Compensation
